

HOW TO DISABLE AND CLEAR AUTOFILL IN GOOGLE CHROME

Autofill is a great timesaving tool however, it can prefill and replace data where it shouldn't and could be dangerous when it comes to online security therefore we recommend that it's turned off.

This tip sheet will walk you through:

- Disable Autofill
- Clear autofill history

Summary

Disable autofill

1. Within your browser click on the Chrome menu Icon (three dots at the top right of the screen)
2. Select settings
3. Find the section labeled- Autofill
 - a. Open each section turn the toggle OFF (if it's on)

Clear autofill data

1. Within your browser click on the Chrome menu Icon (three dots at the top right of the screen)
2. Select History, and History again
3. Click clear browsing data
4. Click on the advanced option
5. Time Range: All Time
6. Make sure the following options are ticked:
 - a. Cached images and files
 - b. Auto form data
7. Click clear browsing data

Disable Autofill

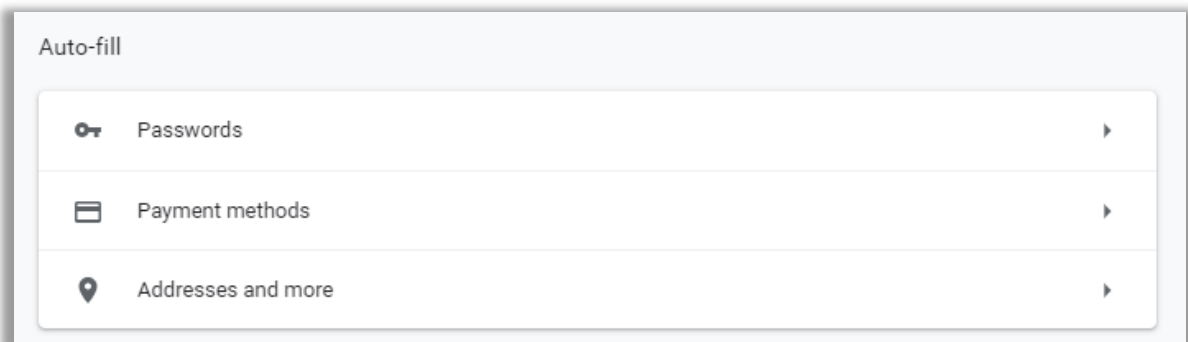
Click the Chrome menu icon (three dots at top right of screen.)



Click on Settings:

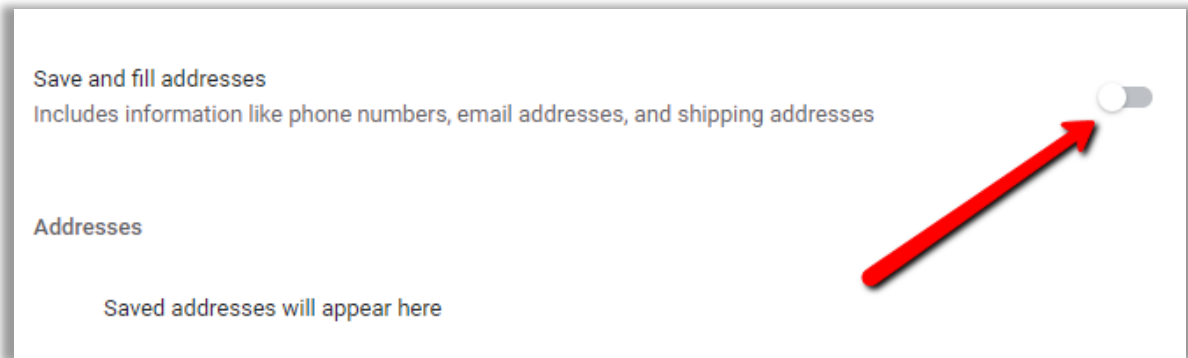


Scroll down and find the **Autofill** Section:



Enter each section and move the toggle to OFF (if its on). The system will automatically save your settings.

Detailed cont.



We then recommend to clear your cache/autofill history.

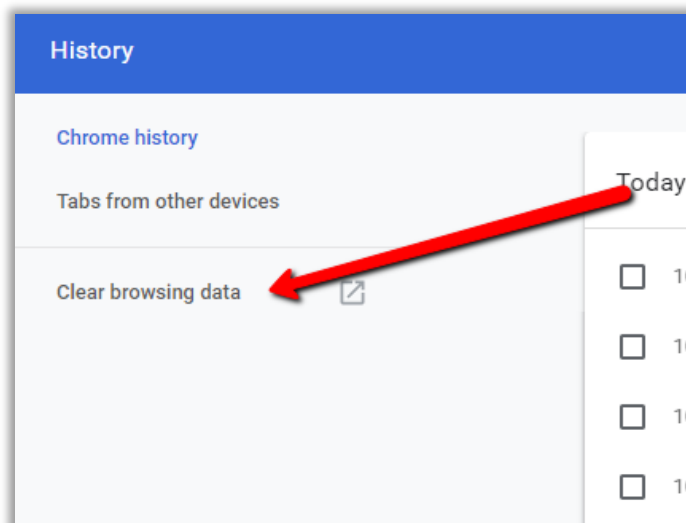
Clearing Autofill Data

Click the Chrome menu icon (Three dots at top right of screen.)

Click on History, then click on History again in the menu that appears.



Select Clear browsing data

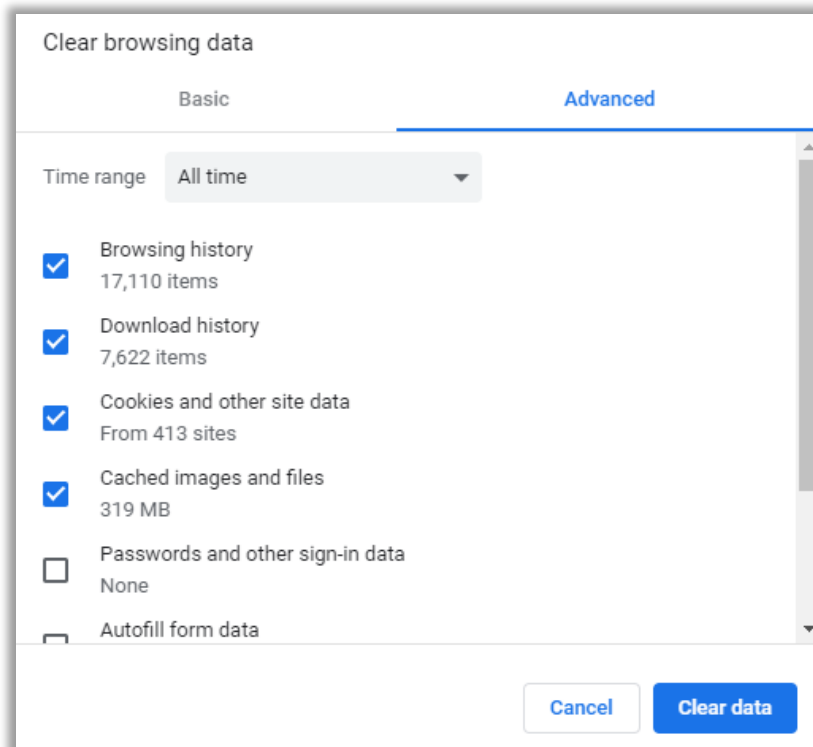


Detailed cont.

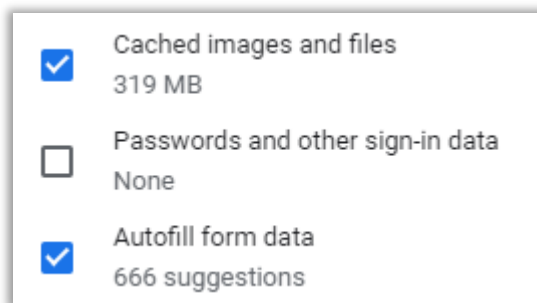
(Alternatively, you can press CTRL+SHIFT+DEL on your keyboard to bypass these steps)

At the top, choose your **Advanced** option.

Time range: All Time option is selected, so that you clear all saved data.



Make sure that **Autofill form data** option is checked along with cached images and files:



Click **Clear browsing data**.

NOTE: This action may take some time to complete, depending on how often you clear your browsing history.
