1. Click on Program & Practices menu
2. Select Program Setup
3. On the Program Categories tab click on +Create
4. Enter name
5. Click Save

4. Enter philosophy
5. Click Save

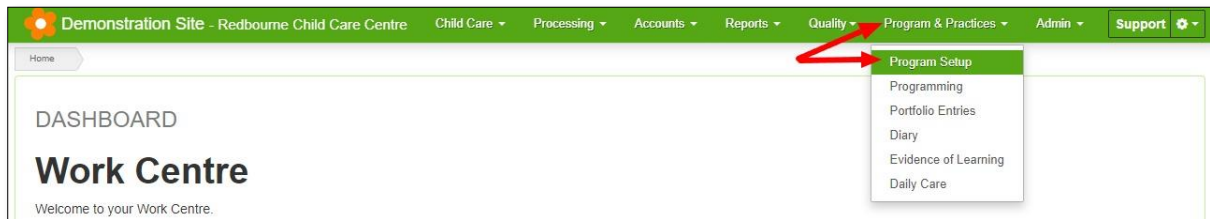
Create Theorists

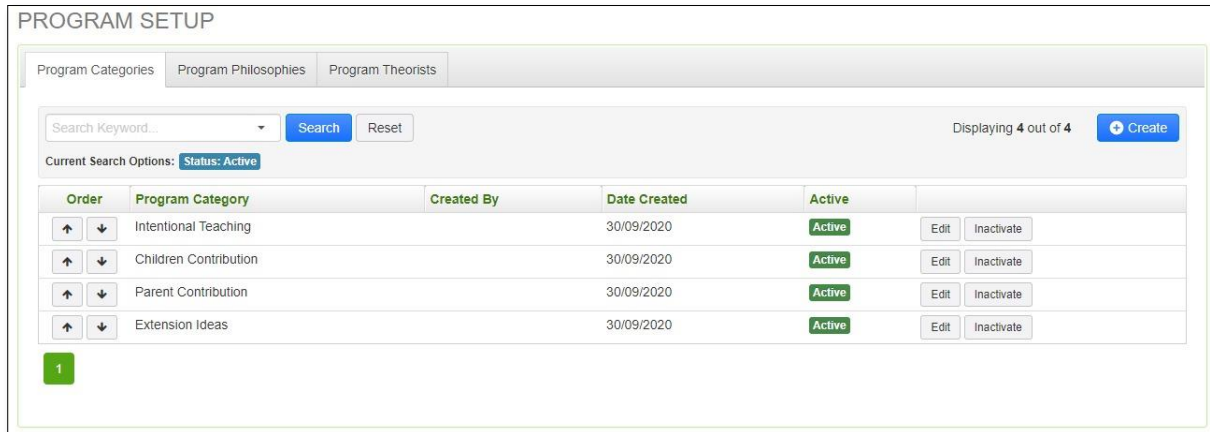

To open this window, navigate to Program & Practices menu and select Program Setup:

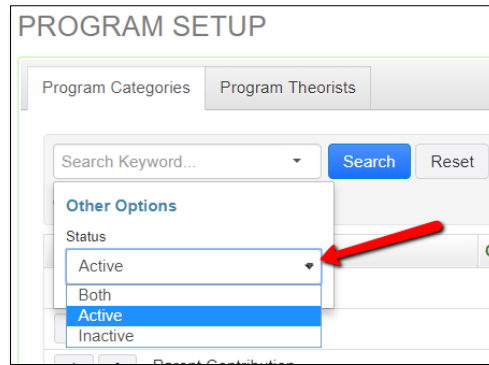


Program Categories

The Program Categories are the main headings to be written to within programming templates.



All active Program Categories will display in the list. You may view inactive categories via the advanced search function.

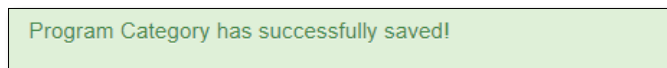


To create a new Program Category, click the **+Create** button.

Enter the category name in the **Add Program Category** window:

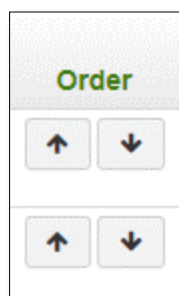


Click the **Save** button to save the record and you will get a successful message:




You may also click the **Inactivate** button to inactivate the record if the Program Category is not in use.

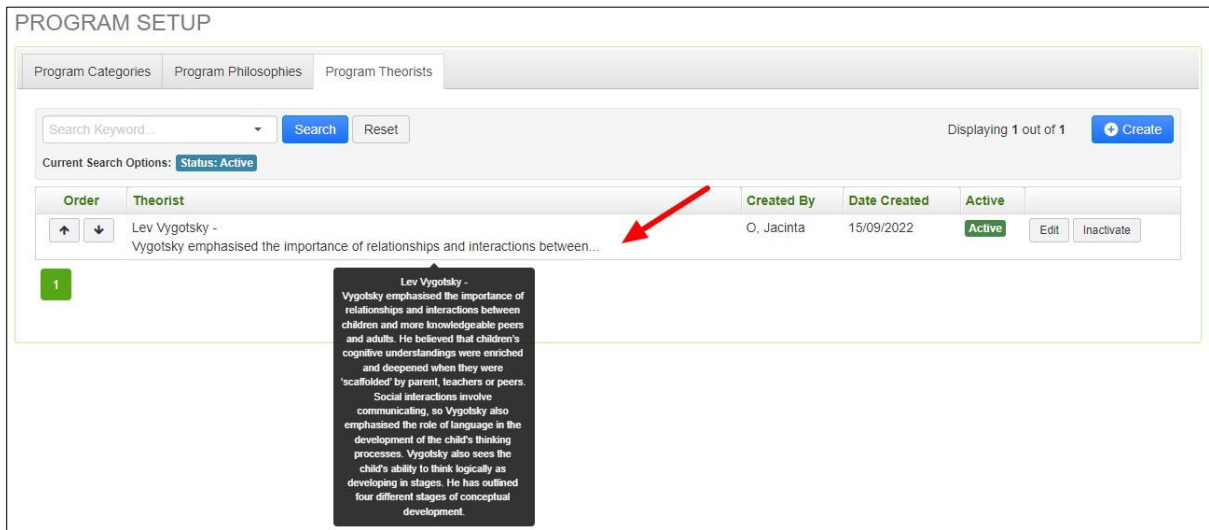
Click the **Save** button to save the record and you will receive a successful message:

The theorist entry will be saved. You may also edit an entry if required:

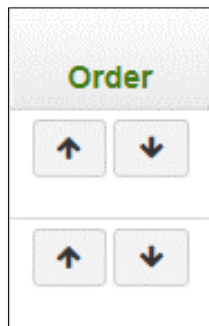


You may hover your mouse over the text for a quick view:

Troubleshooting

Issue: I cannot see the Program & Practices menu.

Why? This will be due to the permissions that have been applied to the role which is assigned to the user.

Resolution: The user will need to have the option called **Program & Practices** set to edit (to enable the user to make changes) or view (to enable the user to see but not make any changes).

To fix this please follow the steps below:

First you need to find what type of permission the user has:

1. Click on the cog settings
2. Select user/personnel
3. Find the user within the list and click edit
4. Click on the Sites tab
5. View the role name assigned to the user:



Next, change permissions for that role:

1. Click on the cog settings
2. Select setup
3. Click on the roles tab
4. Next to edit, click on the down arrow and select Permissions
5. Select the component **Program & Practices**
6. Scroll to find the sub-component Program & Practices
7. Drop down the permission type to select either edit or view
8. Click save
